●●● Program Breakdown ●●●

Children are paired with a trained volunteer tutor who will develop hands-on, engaging activities and games to teach the following foundation literacy skills:

Phonics:

Children will work on developing their phonemic awareness (i.e. word blending and segmenting)

Sight Words:

Children will work on expanding their sight word vocabulary

Fluency:

Children will learn about fluency and how to track it!
Children will read timed passages & be given the opportunity to discuss the words & sections causing them difficulty

Additional Component of the Program:

Self -Regulation & Motivation:

Children will have the opportunity at the end of every instructional block to graph their success. They will track their sight words, fluency, and phonics concepts, and set future goals. This allows them to see their progress and motivates them towards accomplishing their goals!
